4. Grade 12 students scoring at least 65 will be invited to the UBC honours calculus courses, Math 120/121. A special section of Math 223 (Linear Algebra) is offered in the 1st term of 2010/11 for students with a mark of 5 in AP Calculus AB or at least 75% on the UBC-SFU-UVIC-UNBC Calculus Challenge Examination.
