2. The students in Groups I, II, III, and IV and the Euclid Contest Coordinators of the top five schools receiving plaques will be invited to UBC on May 17, 2012 for a special day of activities. Many of the attending Grade 12 students will be awarded UBC Euclid Entrance Scholarships.

3. The Euclid Contest Coordinators of the high ranking schools will be invited to mark the Canadian Open Mathematics Challenge!
4. Grade 12 students scoring at least 65 will be invited to the UBC honours calculus courses, Math 120/121. A special section of Math 223 (Linear Algebra) is offered in the 1st term of 2012/13 for students with a mark of 5 in AP Calculus AB or at least 75% on the UBC-SFU-UVIC-UNBC Calculus Challenge Examination.
